

PLANNING COMMISSION
APRIL 5, 2017

The Village of Combined Locks Planning Commission meeting was called to order by Commission Chairman Al Leicht. Other commission members in attendance included: Tim Mulry, Jeff Maynard, Jim Hamilton, Karen Menting, John Weyenberg, Tracy Melzl, and Cathy Vander Zanden. David Casper and Michael Korn were absent.

Also in attendance was: Village Administrator Racquel Shampo-Giese.

The first item on the agenda was to review and consider approval of the December and February minutes. J. Weyenberg made a motion to approve the minutes. T. Melzl seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was to review the information received regarding a splashpad. The commission members reviewed information gathered from Village of Sherwood officials regarding their experience in constructing and maintaining their splashpad. After a lengthy discussion, the commission members decided that this is not a project they feel is an appropriate expense at this time.

The next item on the agenda was to review the finalized Baseball Tomorrow Fund grant application. The commission members reviewed the questions and answers for the application and noted that completion of the grant application was a great collaboration between village employees and Combined Locks Advancement volunteers. The grant winners are notified in July.

The next item on the agenda was to discuss Centennial Celebration plans. Commission members reviewed options for activities and how to recruit volunteers to help with the planning. The Administrator will write an article for the Times-Villager to start the advertising and recruiting.

In other general business, the commission members with expiring terms noted their wishes to remain on the commission, the Administrator provided a brief update on the business park and the commission members reviewed the condition of Van Zeeland Park and potential for improvements to it.

J. Hamilton made a motion to adjourn the meeting. J. Maynard seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
