Hello,

We are officers Brady Boucher, Edmund Slinde and Captain Scott Lund with Fox Valley Metro Police Department. We have over 40 years of law enforcement experience between us. During that time we have had the unfortunate experience of attending several officers' funerals.

In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15th falls, as National Police Week. In 1984, President Reagan signed into law the legislation that allowed the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund to begin raising money for an appropriate monument in Washington, DC, honoring the fallen law enforcement officers of America. During Police Week a gathering of Police Officers and others takes place in Washington D.C. at the National Law Enforcement Memorial and Museum. It is a time to reflect on the lives of the fallen officers and honor their sacrifices.

In 1997 a group of officers in New Jersey decided to raise money for the Memorial and Museum by riding their bicycles from Florham Park NJ to the Memorial and Museum with the hope of bringing public awareness of Police Officers who have died in the line of duty. With that ride the Police Unity Tour was created. The primary purpose of the Police Unity Tour is to raise awareness of Law Enforcement Officers who have died in the line of duty. The secondary purpose is to raise funds for the National Law Enforcement Officer's Memorial and Museum. The motto of the Police Unity Tour is "We ride for those who died."

We would like to participate in the 2012 ride and help to honor those fallen officers. We would be riding in honor of Officer Craig Birkholz of the Fond du Lac Police Department who was killed during a standoff in March of 2011.

In order for us to ride we need your help. We are trying to raise \$4,100 for the Memorial Fund. The money will be used for the maintenance of the Memorial and Museum; including re-engraving, coating and sealing of the 18,983 names on the memorial, as well as cleaning of the walls and other memorial improvements.
