REMINDERS FROM OUR FIRE DEPARTMENT ABOUT OUTDOOR FIRES

The Village of Combined Locks permits outdoor burning with a few caveats:

- Only natural, clean wood may be burned in campfires / bonfires.
- What exactly does clean wood mean?
 - Clean wood is NOT painted or treated with any material to alter its appearance or finish.
 Only natural unfinished wood may be burned.



Location:

• Campfire pits must be no closer than 25 feet from any combustible surface or material.

Hours that campfires are allowed

- Campfires must be extinguished before 11:00pm Sunday through Thursday.
- Campfires must be extinguished before 1:00am on Saturday and Sunday.

Additional items

- Keep in mind that burning campfires may not create a nuisance for neighbors.
- Additionally, the fires must always be supervised by a person 18 or older.
- Water or extinguishment material must be readily available in the event it escapes your control.
- Yard waste is allowed to be burned as along as certain provisions are met. Read Village ordinance <u>Chapter 252 Burning</u>, <u>Outdoors</u> for specifics.
- No person may have, maintain or use a burning barrel to burn refuse (garbage, cardboard, building materials, etc.)
- The Fire Chief has the authority to enact a "Burn Ban" in the Village if weather conditions warrant (extremely dry and windy conditions are present.)

Again, we all need to be good neighbors and not create a nuisance from smoke or smell for our neighbors.
